**NET Examination: Modalities** 

**Introduction:** The National Testing Agency (NTA) has been entrusted by the University Grants Commission (UGC) with the task of conducting UGC-NET, which is a Test to determine the eligibility of Indian nationals for 'Assistant Professor' as well as 'Junior Research Fellowship and Assistant Professor' in Indian Universities and Colleges.

The UGC-NET is being conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) in Computer Based Test (CBT) mode w.e.f. December 2018 onwards.

UGC-NET is conducted twice every year (June & December). In order to regularize the UGC-NET examination cycle, the National Testing Agency (NTA), with the concurrence of UGC is conducting UGC NET June 2023.

**Scheme of the Exam**: The exam has two papers. One compulsory Paper and another one in the subject area.

**Our Training:** We are going to offer Training for Paper-1 and English. Since NET is taken by students of diversified backgrounds, we will extend the course to other subjects over a period of Time.

Class Size: 50 students

**Duration of the course**: 3 Months (75 days approx.) August to November Mid.

**Timings:** Four Hours of training is provided on a daily basis on all working days.
